SOS CHILDREN'S VILLAGE ALIBAUG

INTRODUCTION

Alibaug or Alibag is present in the Raigad District of Maharashtra. It is 30 km south of Mumbai and is easily reachable by road. The place mostly lives off its tourist related activities which includes various fishing and agriculture related activities; these activities have been a major source of livelihood for many in the area.

Alibaug has seen rapid migration of people from all across India, this shift is in their quest for a better standard of living. Since the increase in population is drastic, the area also suffers from widespread poverty and underemployment. The most affected groups of such situations are women and children, who find it

hard to adapt to the changing environment. Due to this, children are forced to drop out of schools and women are left with no choice but to engage more in daily wage activities in order to support their families.

The SOS Children's Village in Alibaug, near Mumbai, started its activities in the year 2010. There are 14 Family Homes at our facility where children are placed under the care of SOS Mothers, two SOS Aunts and two SOS Mother Trainees.

Once a child is welcomed in the SOS Family, all necessary efforts are made to cater to his/her emotional and physical needs. Children are placed under the loving care of an SOS Mother and are also helped to get acquainted with other children in the family home; children who stay together in a family home are regarded as brothers and sisters.

SOS Children'S Village Alibaug

Children in our villages are always and constantly motivated to perform better in life. Academics and co-curricular activities are regarded to be equally important for overall growth and development of a child. The provision of tuitions for children is made in all our villages, where children are rendered help and support with their studies. In addition, special coaching and training is also given to those who reflect potential in the fields of art, sports, music, dance etc. At an SOS Village, all festivals of national and international importance are celebrated with great joy and enthusiasm. Children along with their mothers, brothers and sisters, aunts and all co-workers of the village engage in celebrations that continue for the whole day; this serves as a good bonding time between the children and their family members.

SOS Youth

At present, the total number of youth under our facility in Alibaug is 36. While some of our youth are still studying in school, others are enrolled in college. Academic results of all our children have been consistently good and have only improved over the years. In the board examination results for class X and XII, a pass percentage of 100% has been witnessed.

Various awareness programmes and sessions are held for our children in order to keep them updated about the on-going issues in our society.

While many of our youth are enrolled in well-paying jobs, others are well settled and happily married.

Family Strengthening Programme (FSP)

The Family Strengthening Programme was initiated in Alibaug in order to help vulnerable families become self-reliant. At present, the FSP in Alibaug renders support to 644 beneficiaries under its care.

SOS India not only provides financial aid to families but also works towards their capacity building by working towards their skill development.

Another way by which such families are supported is via Self Help Groups. It is a concept where people from the same socio-economic background come together to solve common problem through mutual help.

Various training sessions and seminars are held for the beneficiaries under the FSP in order to help them realize their highest potential. The aim of an FSP is to pull out families out of the circle of poverty. Once a family becomes self-independent, it exits the programme and is replaced by a new family in need of support.

- From the perspective of children meeting a new teacher, there's often a mix of curiosity, apprehension, and excitement which could clearly be seen in their eyes.
- They were keen to learn from the next day about their subjects as well as our cultures.
- We were given time tables to help the students of different classes at different times.
- There were separate sessions for students of different classes.
- Morning sessions included students of classes 6,7 and 8.
- Afternoon sessions included primary school children.
- Evening sessions contained students of classes 10 and 11.
- As all the 3 teachers were from science background, so the main focus of the sessions was to help them get a good hold on concepts of Science and Maths.
- Intern Shikha Bhatt (M.Sc Zoology) helped the students in Biology and Chemistry.
- Intern Kiran Rawat (M.Sc Maths) helped the students in Chemistry and Maths.
- Intern Gurjan Khatri (M.Sc. Physics) helped the students in Physics and Maths.
- As for primary school children the focus on language and communication (English), and Basic Mathematics.
- By addressing misconceptions and providing factual information, pupil teachers empowered the students to make informed decisions about their sexual health and well-being, fostering a culture of respect, understanding, and responsibility.
- Christmas day was celebrated with great joy and enthusiasm. All the children, mothers and staff gathered around, danced and had dinner together.
- One fine day CHHATRAPATI SHIVAJI MAHARAJ VASTU SANGRAHALAYA (MUSEUM ON WHEELS) was on the campus of SOS Alibaug. The exhibition themes are selected keeping in mind school curricula and draws from the CSMVS' vast collection of antiquities. These mobile exhibitions are taken to various educational and cultural institutions for deeper and wider engagement with heritage, arts and sciences. The Buses are fully equipped with display cases for objects, replicas, models and dioramas. Audio-visual equipment and digital media including touch screens and tablets further engage this generation of tech-savvy children. At the same time, interactive demo-kits, art and craft activities get children working with their hands, thus offering them a holistic learning experience.

The town of Bawana is located in the north-west area of New Delhi. SOS Children's Village Bawana was built in the year 1974 and is located on the outskirts of the town. A large number of people have been seen migrating to Bawana because of its closeness that it shares with the capital city.

Bawana is the second location where the SOS Children's Village started to work in. It was built in 1974 with the aim of providing abandoned or parentless children a loving family like environment to grow up in. At present, the village consists of 171 children living in 16 Family Homes.

SOS India functions around building a loving and an everlasting bond between the child and his SOS family. Festivals of both National and International importance are celebrated with great enthusiasm

in the SOS Villages. Children along with their mothers, brother and sisters and other village co-workers participate in various activities that help them develop trust and strengthen relationships.

DISTANCE

1. The SOS Children's Village In Bawana Is 14.3 kms away from the Holambi Kalan Railway Station.
2. It is at a distance of 39.1 kms from the Indra Gandhi International Airport.

SOS YOUTH

At present, the total number of youth under our care adds up to 108. Children at SOS Villages are enrolled in formal schools and are exposed to all kinds of co-curricular activities. Vocational training is also provided to children in some of our villages. In order to help children perform their best, arrangements for tuition classes, computer classes and English speaking classes are made in the SOS Village.

Youth are motivated to take part in all kinds of intra and inter school competitions that their school organizes. Children are given all the help they require to realize their highest potential in order to make them responsible citizens of the country. Various career counseling sessions are organized for children to help them make the right decision in choosing the field they aspire to build their careers in.

FAMILY STRENGTHENING PROGRAMME (FSP)

The Family Strengthening Programme in our NGO in Bawana, Delhi was initiated in 2003. The purpose of introducing this scheme in the town was to empower and support families who could not sustain solely on their own. Besides financial backing, SOS also works towards the capacity building of these individuals, for which, a number of training sessions are organized by SOS India for all families under the FSP

At present, the total number of beneficiaries under our FSP In Bawana add up to 351. Once a family self-reliant, it automatically gets phased out from the FSP and is replaced by another family.

The school is Not Applicable in nature and is not using school building as a shift-school. Hindi is the medium of instructions in this school. This school is approachable by all weather road. In this school academic session starts in April.

The school has Private building. It has got 12 classrooms for instructional purposes. All the classrooms are in good condition. It has 2 other rooms for non-teaching activities. The school has a separate room for Head master/Teacher. The school has Pucca boundary wall. The school has have electric connection. The source of Drinking Water in the school is Tap Water and it is functional. The school has 3 boys toilet and it is functional, and 3 girls toilet and it is functional. The school has a playground. The school has a library and has 2700 books in its library. The school does not need ramp for disabled children to access classrooms. The school has 8 computers for teaching and learning purposes and all are functional. The school is having a computer aided learning lab.

- We were instructed to help the students of different classes at evening

- There were separate sessions for students of different classes.

- To build confidence & Morale in students we encouraged them to do White Board duties.





In urban areas like Gurugram, Faridabad, and Chandigarh, life is fast-paced with modern amenities, employment opportunities, and a vibrant cultural scene. These cities boast of well-developed infrastructure, shopping malls, restaurants, and recreational facilities.

In rural areas, life is more traditional, centered around agriculture and community life. People often have close-knit relationships with their neighbors and follow customs and traditions deeply rooted in the local culture.

The curriculum at Hermann Gmeiner School in Faridabad typically follows a well-rounded approach to education, focusing not only on academic subjects but also on character building, creativity, and social responsibility. While specific details may vary, the school's curriculum likely aligns with national educational standards while incorporating elements of international best practices. So students here come from a variety of intellectual, cultural, and financial backgrounds. In order to meet each student's unique needs and guarantee that they all have equal opportunity to learn and develop, managing such diversity calls for individualized attention.

We found that in particular, when working with a big student population of different personalities and temperaments, managing student behavior, disciplinary concerns, and maintaining a positive school climate is difficult here.

We never used ICR before but when we came to HGS Faridabad we got our hands on ICR this was another level of experience for us. It is specially designed to meet the unique needs of students.



To create individualized learning plans, teachers in an ICR classroom concentrate on knowing the strengths, weaknesses, and learning preferences of each student. To address academic, behavioral, social, or emotional needs, this may entail specific interventions, accommodations, adjustments, and differentiated instruction. Teachers hope to establish an inclusive learning environment where each student can flourish and realize their full potential by putting ICR ideas into practice.

The SOS Children' Village in Jaipur was established in 1976. It is situated in a residential area, and is about 2 km from the railway station. The architectural style of the family houses in the village is built with respect to the tradition of the region. The buildings here are also constructed in accordance to the weather conditions, where the roofs are flat, and serve as a sleeping area during the hot season. Our NGO in Jaipur for children consists of 14 Family Homes, a Kindergarten serving as a day care center for young children, a well-equipped computer laboratory, basketball and volleyball courts, an auditorium, a library and a medical dispensary. At present, our Village in Jaipur consists of 133 children.

Located in the heart of Rajasthan, Jaipur is the capital of this colourful culture-rich state. The city is also known as the Pink City for its beautiful palaces and buildings tainted with pink. If development in the city is only increasing, there is also an increase in the number of individuals who're suffering because of the same due to the limited resources available. These are people, who're unable to access proper health and sanitation facilities, and often end up with illnesses. This gives way to either families where parents are not fit to cater to the needs of their children, or where children have lost their parents to unfortunate events. This is where the role of SOS India, one of the top NGOs in Jaipur comes into picture, where thousands of parentless or abandoned children are supported by our organization.

FAMILY STRENGTHENING PROGRAMME (FSP)

The Family Strengthening Programme in Jammu was initiated in the year 2010. Our vision through this programme is to uplift families from the weaker section of society and help them reach self-sustainability.

At present, the FSP in Jammu has 385 beneficiaries under its care. In order to help these families become independent, various capacity building activities and workshops are conducted for them to realize their highest potential and improve their income generating ability. With the FSP intervention in Jammu, noticeable improvements have been seen in the living standards of families under our care.

During the year, various awareness programmes are organized by SOS India for beneficiaries under FSP, where they are educated on issues such as health and hygiene, child care and protection, parenting techniques etc. In addition, activities for children in the Children's Club were also conducted for their holistic development.

SOS YOUTH

At the age of 14, our youth boys are shifted to the Youth House where they continue their progress. At present, the number of youth at our facility in Jammu goes up to 68. While many of our children are enrolled in schools, others are pursuing their bachelor's and master's degree courses from colleges.

In order to give our youth exposure, various excursions and tour visits are organized. Picnics are also conducted for children and their caregivers where a day out of fun-filled activities is planned; this serves as a bonding time between children and their family members.

The number of children enrolled in the Hermann Gmeiner School, Jammu, now goes over 1000. The pass rate of children taking the board exam for class X and XII in the school has now reached 100%, which is a great achievement in itself.

Children in HGS are active in co-curricular activities, especially sports; they have participated in championships at both levels; State and National.

SOS CHILDREN'S VILLAGE JAMMU

The SOS Children's Village in Jammu started its activities in the year 1998. At present, there are over 100 children living in 12 family homes under the Family Based Care Program at the village. These children are placed under the care of nine SOS Mothers, who are assisted by five SOS Aunts who help them with their day to day activities.

Children at SOS CV Jammu attend regular schools and colleges; academic results of all our children have shown significant improvement over the years. Not only are they encouraged working hard in their studies, they are also driven to actively take part in extracurricular activities.

All festivals of national and international importance are celebrated with joy at SOS CV Jammu. Such celebrations involve all children, mothers and other village co-workers, who gather together to enjoy festivities.

Jammu has been affected by years of violence due to clashes between Muslims and Hindus. The instability in the area has resulted in families moving out of town and living elsewhere as refugees.

The majority of the poor people in Jammu lives in rural areas but over the years, an increase in urban poverty have also been witnessed since people migrate to cities in search of better opportunities and livelihood. However, there is not enough infrastructure and resources to cater to the needs of the increasing population; this has resulted in an increase in slums in Jammu.

Families living under poverty struggle on a daily basis to make their ends meet. Parents are often unable to cater to the emotional and physical needs of their children; children are also forced to drop out of school and help their family in household chores.
